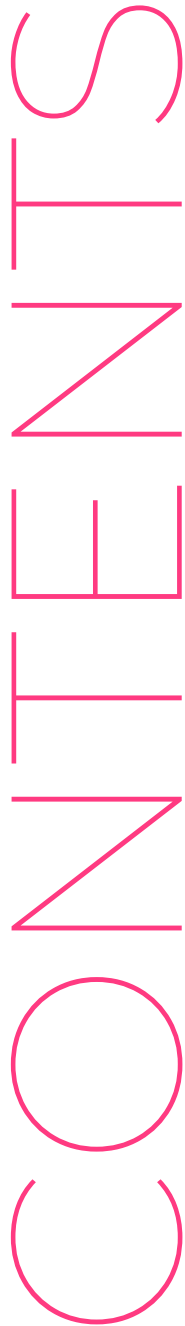

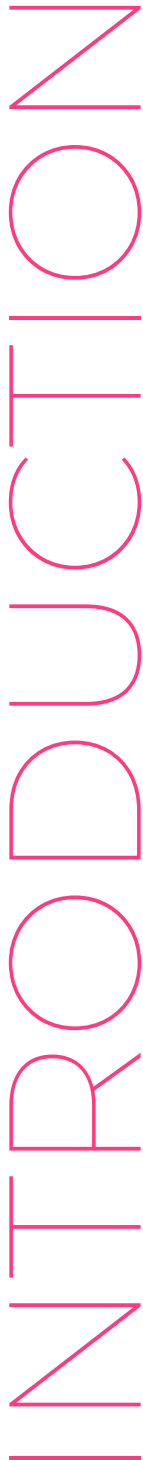

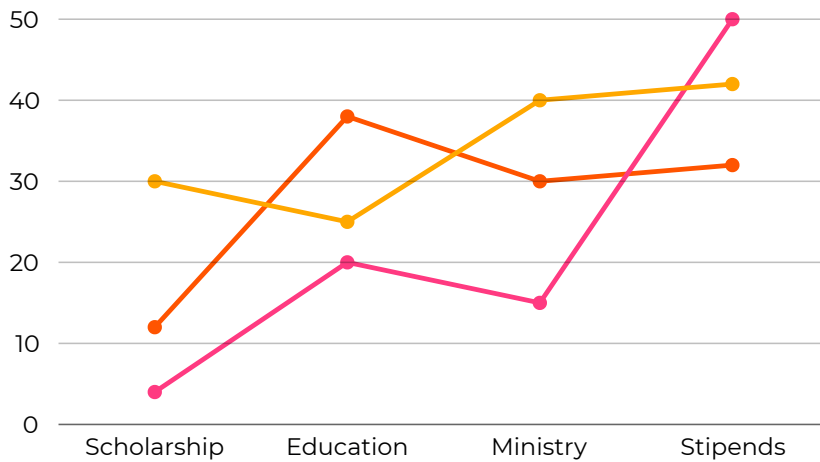

Priority: OutTeach
